2. All exhibits must be the product of the exhibitor's labors. Baked items must be made from scratch without the use of mixes. Submit recipe. Sewn and needlework items may be produced using patterns or kits. In the Horticulture Division, plants may have been started from seed or purchased and transplanted, except Classes 2 and 3 in the Specialty Division, Division XI, which may have been purchased.
3. Each exhibitor **may** enter more than one entry in each class.
4. Every entry will receive a ribbon. Division winners will receive special awards. Best of Show from A. Fabrics and Fiber B. Food C. Horticulture and D. Woodworking will receive \$25 each and other special awards.
