SHOW RULES:

1. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and its rules shall govern. The sponsoring organization is Stars & Stripes Livestock.
2. *Separately sanctioned ADGA shows will be held for registered does of the following breeds: Alpines, LaMancha, Saanen, Nubian, Nigerian Dwarf, Recorded Grade, Toggenburg and Oberhasli.* The judges will change rings, eliminating the need to change locations of the animals waiting to be shown. After completion of the Combined Jr. - Sr. Doe Shows, The Junior Doe Show and Unsanctioned Youth Combined Jr.- Sr. Show will begin in the same order. The order of the show will be as follows:

3. The base date for computing animal ages is July 10, 2010.
  4. The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and must be shown to the Show Secretary prior to the start of the judging. For animals less than six months of age, either the original or a duplicate application stamped by the ADGA office is acceptable. Proof of animal's ownership is the name on the registration certificate or on the stamped duplicate.
5. **Goats from NJ** must present either a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) or an Animal Health Certificate (AHC). Sexually intact goats must be identified by USDA approved identification (approved ear tag and/or tattoo or microchip.) If microchip is used, you must bring the reader. **Goats from out of State** must present an official CVI. Exhibitor's USDA Scrapie Premise number should be on all health certificates. You may "import" (transport) goats from an accredited-free state without testing for brucellosis upon receipt of a permit number for entry. Permit numbers maybe obtained by calling the NJ Division of Animal Health at 609-292-3965 between 8:45 and 4:30 Monday through Friday. You must record: name of owner, National premise Identification Number or Scrapie Identification Number, address of premise of origin, address of destination (Horse Park of NJ, PO Box 419, Cream Ridge, NJ 08514). Approved USDA Mandatory Identification ear-tags and/or tattoo or microchip are required and the number must be on the CVI. 6. Any animal appearing in poor health or displaying open abscesses or obvious signs of sore-mouth or pinkeye may not be shown. The show committee shall have the authority to request the removal of such an animal from the fairgrounds.
7. Champions have the option of being shown in their age classes or in the Champion Challenge class. When entering animals on the entry forms, please list senior does first, then juniors. List animals by breed, and enter classes in numerical order.
8. **Entries must be postmarked on or before July 1, 2010** and must be accompanied by an entry fee of \$4.00 per animal per show if showing in both rings or \$4.50 per animal if showing in only one ring. Entries postmarked after July 1, 2010 must be accompanied by an additional late fee of \$4.00 per animal. **Make checks payable to Stars & Stripes Livestock. THERE WILL BE A \$30.00 CHARGE FOR CHECKS NOT HONORED BY THE EXHIBITOR'S BANK.**
9. **All Open Doe Show entries must be checked in by 8:30 am.** All Junior Doe Show entries must be checked in by 9:00 am. The show will start **PROMPTLY** at 8:30 am with *Class 4.* (age 15 to 21 years) Showmanship in ring 1 and *Class 3.* (11 to 14 years) Showmanship in ring 2, followed by *Class 2.* (6 to 10 years) Showmanship in ring 1 and *Class 1.* (5 and under) Showmanship in ring 2. Judging of the Senior Doe Show will begin at the completion of the Showmanship classes.
10. **Pens ARE NOT available.** There will be a limited number of holding pens for animals before being brought into the show rings. There will be plenty of space available for portable pens or tie space. Bring your own hay, feed, & bedding. **All exhibitors must leave their area in the same condition as they found it. This includes the area around trailers and in the arena.**
11. Exhibitors should have their animals in the holding area and ready to enter the ring before the judging of the previous class is completed. No animal may enter the ring after the judging has begun.

12. This show is being held as an activity sponsored by Stars & Stripes Livestock and will be held in conjunction with the Freedom Fest State Fair, at the Horse Park of New Jersey. ***The Horse Park of New Jersey, Freedom Fest State Fair and Stars & Stripes Livestock will not be responsible for loss, damage, theft, or accident to any person, animal, or property. Show entry indicates acceptance of this condition.*** Show will be held rain or shine.

**Directions to the Horse Park of New Jersey at Stone Tavern:**

1. From the NJ Turnpike – (7 ½ miles) Take Exit 7A to Rt. 195 East to Exit 11. Make a left onto Imlaystown-Hightstown Rd., then make a right on Rt. 524. The Horse Park is on the left, approximately 1 ½ miles.
2. From the Garden State Parkway – (26 miles) Take Exit 9B to Rt. 195 West to Exit 11. Make a right onto Imlaystown-Hightstown Rd, then make a right on Rt. 524. The Horse Park is on your left, approximately 1 ½ miles.
